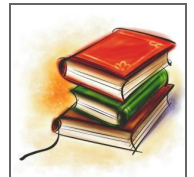
Classes as usual for Grades 8-12. Grades 8 & 9 mid-term exams end this Friday.

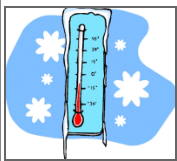
